ThinkNL releases numbers on employment levels at the House of Assembly and Memorial University

St. John's, NL - February 16, 2015 - Continuing its commitment to provide simplified, non-partisan data concerning the operations of the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador, ThinkNL has released two new metrics. As stated in its initial Press Conference, ThinkNL provides these without commentary as to whether they are reasonable or in fact require further evaluation by Government.

- **49 for 48** This represents the number of employees of the House of Assembly supporting the 48 MHAs.

- **1 for 3.18** This represents the number of full and part time employees at Memorial University (1) for every 3.18 full and part time students.
